Stunning islands: St Lucia and Dominica

Although St Lucia is not considered a saint by everyone, the island is certainly the true queen of this idyllic realm. Even from a distance, its twin volcanic peaks, the Pitons, proffer a regal greeting to the approaching SEA CLOUD II. And once we have docked, the island welcomes us with its lush tropical scenery. Dominica, unofficially dubbed "Nature Island", is proud of its unspoilt scenery. One of its national parks is even a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

"The Baths" – imposing granite formations

It is sometimes easy to think that this is one of nature's fairy tales: Once upon a time, there was a giant who played with large stone marbles. His favorite playground was in Virgin Gorda, a place now called "The Baths" – a gigantic rock labyrinth made out of circular-shaped granite boulders.

Regatta on the jetset island of St Barths

The fact that St Barths can only be reached by small aircraft often attracts international celebrities who come to enjoy relaxing days on the tranquil beach or head to the capital of Gustavia. A highlight for sports fans is the Bucket Regatta, a remarkable sailing event which is held in March every year and sees 30 stylish superyachts compete against one another.
