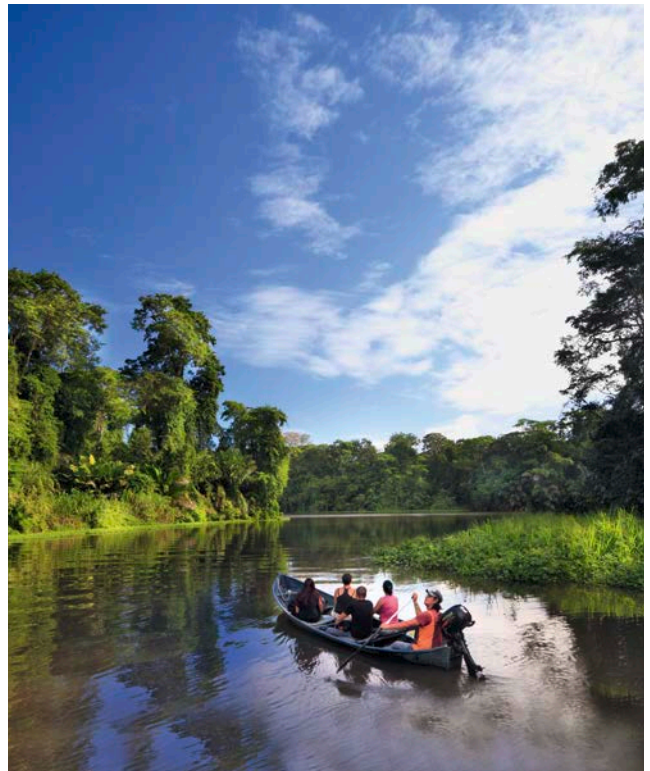
Our local expert on board:
