YOUR OPTIONAL BICYCLE EXCURSION PACKAGE:

Sun, Jul 09, 2023 Copenhagen/Denmark

Copenhagen's residents love cycling. And visitors notice this immediately because the city is ideal for cyclists. Experience the historic old town on our bike excursion and guided walking tour. You will visit Frederiksstaden, the rococo district where Amalienborg Castle is located, the pretty harbor of Nyhavn, Copenhagen's landmark Christiansborg Castle set in beautiful gardens, the Renaissance Rosenborg Castle, and the Hermitage hunting lodge. **Bike: 35 km**

Mon, Jul 10, 2023 Kalmar/Sweden

Kalmar Castle tour.
The Renaissance castle in Kalmar is the country's best known medieval castle. **Bike: 26 km**

Wed, Jul 12, 2023 Gdansk/Poland

From the harbor, we take you to the restored old town of Gdansk for a guided tour of the city. Afterward, a bike excursion takes you from Gdansk to the coast to visit the fashionable seaside resorts of Sopot and Gdynia. A short transfer brings you back to the ship. **Bike: 35 km**

Thu, Jul 13, 2023 Klaipeda/Lithuania

You will arrive on the Curonian Spit by ferry. A beautiful cycle path leads through the forest and old fishing villages of Joudkrante (Black Shore), Preila, and Pervalka. In Black Shore, you can visit the Hill of Witches, home to wooden figures from Lithuanian mythology. **Bike: 40 km**

Sat, Jul 15, 2023 Riga/Latvia

In the morning, you will cross the Daugava River and leave the city via hidden routes. You will be amazed at the many wonderfully preserved wooden houses in Riga. The first stage of the bike tour takes you to Jūrmala on the coast, the Baltic Sea's most popular and opulent resort. On a guided tour of Riga in the afternoon, you will discover medieval alleys, as well as traces of the Hanseatic League and German culture. **Bike: 32 km**

Mon, Jul 17, 2023 Visby/Gotland/Sweden

Gotland, Sweden's largest island, lies like a jewel in the Baltic Sea. From enchanting Visby, with its historic buildings and flourishing gardens, we cycle to the Höglint nature reserve, taking in breathtaking views along the Baltic coast. **Bike: 28 km**

Tue, Jul 18, 2023 Stockholm/Sweden

The Swedish capital invites visitors to see its many sights on a bike tour from Djurgården, Stockholm's green island, to the Vasa Museum and the old town Gamla Stan. You will pass countless striking buildings that reflect the city's prosperity. A walking tour of the old town completes the morning in Stockholm. **Bike: 25 km**



The terranova bicycle program includes:

- 4 guided tours in Copenhagen, Gdansk, Riga and Stockholm
- 7 guided bicycle tours including all transfers
- A rental bike with 7-gear back pedal or with a 24-gear free-wheel chain/hub gear (you will need to reserve this in advance)
- Technical maintenance of the bikes during the cruise
- A terranova tour guide
- All-round service including breaks with drinks and substantial picnic lunches
